### ADT Requirements

Transfer degrees require the following:

1. Complete all required courses for a major with a grade of "C" or better.
2. Complete 60 CSU-transferable units. At least 12 of the 60 units must be earned at Sacramento City College.
3. Complete one of the following general education (GE) patterns. Meet with your SCC Counselor to discuss the appropriate GE pattern for your individual transfer/graduation goals:

- CSU General Education Breadth Requirements
- Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) – CSU option

### Placement Information

**\*\*If you don't place directly in STAT 300 (check your e-Services account), you will need to take STAT 10/PSYC 330 or STAT 10/STAT 300 combo course. PSYC 330 is the recommended statistics course for students transferring to CSU Sacramento.**

\*Major Elective - A minimum of 3 units from the following: PSYC 315, PSYC 320 or PSYC 370/EDUC 300. A class used to fulfill the previous major elective cannot also be used to meet this requirement. Faculty suggest that students planning to major in Psychology at CSU Sacramento take PSYC 370.

Support courses required for English and Math per placement. **Check your e-Services account under "Academic Records" to determine your placements.**

### Counselor Notes

- All AA-Ts and AS-Ts are designed to transfer to CSUs in most majors. **Students who wish to transfer to a UC are strongly encouraged to meet with a counselor to determine additional major requirements.**
- Math – you may have other options for transfer level math; check with your counselor.
- Students with Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate Credit (IB) test scores should notify their counselor to learn more about how test scores may be used for credit.**

### Department Faculty Note

Faculty strongly recommend that students transferring to CSU Sacramento take PSYC 330 instead of STAT 300 for their Statistics requirement. All Psychology majors who have a STAT 300 placement on E-Services are eligible to take PSYC 330 instead of STAT 300. Faculty also suggest that students transferring to CSU Sacramento take PSYC 370 as a major elective. Students transferring to other universities should consult with a counselor to determine which Statistics and major elective courses to take.
