Community College Pathway to Law School is a transfer program designed to enhance opportunities in the legal profession for diverse populations. While racial or ethnic minorities

comprise 60 percent of the California population, only 20 percent of the state's lawyers are minorities.

### **Program Requirements of Law School Pathway Project**

In order to successfully complete this program, the student must:

- Complete the Community College Pathway to Law School orientation
- Meet with a SCC counselor to create a Student Educational Plan
- Successfully complete the required courses while in residence at Sacramento City College
- Agree to release information pertinent to the program
- Graduate/transfer from Sacramento City College
