Associate Degrees require the following:

- Completion of a minimum of 60 degree-applicable units with an overall grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 ("C" average). A minimum of 12 units must be completed at Sacramento City College.
- Completion of each required course with a grade of "C" or better for a major offered at Sacramento City College.
- 3. Completion of <u>Sacramento City College's general education requirements</u> Area I; Area II(a) and II(b); Area III(a) and III(b), or Area III(c); Area IV; Area V; and Area VI with an overall 2.0 GPA.
- Completion of all three <u>competency requirements</u> (reading, writing, and mathematics).

Students with Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate Credit (IB) test scores should notify their Counselor to learn more about how test scores may be used for credit.
