Career Options:

This certificate prepares students to be American Sign Language / English interpreters.

Scheduling Notes:

- INTRP 300, 301, 303, 320, 334, 336, 340, 342, 344, 349, and 352 are offered in the fall.
- INTRP 305, 307, 310, 312, 314, 325, 330,332, 350, 354, and 356 are offered in the spring.
- DEAF 370 is offered in the fall.
- DEAF 352 and 355 are offered in the spring.
- DEAF 318 and 351 are offered in the fall and spring.

Other Notes:

- Students must have a high school diploma or equivalent to enter the program.
- The ASL-English Interpreter Preparation program currently accepts students once per year for the fall semester, which begins in August. The deadline to submit an application is the second Friday in April.
- The selection process includes an interview/screening process conducted by the Interpreter Preparation Program.
- Only students who meet the preenrollment requirements and follow the pre-enrollment process will be considered for the program.
