CAREER PATH

Career Options:

- Speech-Language Pathology Assistant (school districts, private practice, adult rehabilitation)
- Instructional Assistant (school districts)

Scheduling Notes:

- SLPA 115, 120 and 126 are offered in the fall.
- SLPA 110, 116, and 121 are offered in the spring.
- All SLPA courses are offered in the evening except SLPA 115, which is scheduled two days a week in the afternoon because of the lab component of working in the ARC Child Development Center.
- SLPA 121 requires students to complete 162 hours of supervised field experience during the day.

Other Notes:

- This program can be started in the spring as well. See a counselor to adjust the coursework.
- SLPA 115 requires a medical clearance, including TB clearance (within 12 months), measles vaccination, pertussis vaccination, and (optional) flu vaccination.
- SLPA 121 requires a TB clearance, CPR/First Aid certification, Live Scan, and malpractice insurance.
