AA/AS Requirements

Associate Degrees require the following:

- Completion of a minimum of 60 degree-applicable units with an overall grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 ("C" average). A minimum of 12 units must be completed within the Los Rios Community College District.
- 2. Completion of each required course with a grade of "C" or better for a major offered at Sacramento City College.
- 3. Completion of <u>Sacramento City Colleg</u> <u>e's local AA/AS degree general educat</u> <u>ion requirements</u> – Area L1A and L1B; Area L2; Area L3; Area L4; Area L5; and Area L6; and Area L7A and L7B – with an overall 2.0 GPA. Students also have an option of completing the <u>Calif</u> <u>ornia General Education Transfer Curr</u> <u>iculum (Cal-GETC)</u> instead of the local general education pattern.

Students with Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate Credit (IB) test scores should notify their Counselor to learn more about how test scores may be used for credit. **If you don't place directly in ENGL C1000 (check your eServices account), you will need to take ENGWR 80/ENGL C1000 combo course.
