**+Prerequisite for ENGL C1000 & ENGWR 488:** Placement through assessment process; students who don't place directly in ENGL C1000 (check your e-Services account) will need to take ENGWR 80/ENGL C1000 combo course.

**+Prerequisite for ESLW 340:** ESL 325 with a grade of "C" or better; or, for students not previously enrolled in ESL writing courses within the Los Rios district, placement through the Los Rios assessment process

**+ Prerequisite for BUS 310:** BUS 100, ENGL C1000, or ESLW 340 with a grade of "C" or better

**+ Prerequisite for ENGL C1001:** College-level composition (ENGL C1000/ENGL C1000H/ENGL C1000E/C-ID ENGL 100) or equivalent
