AA/AS Requirements

This Associate Degree requires the following:

1. **Completion of a minimum of 60 degree-applicable units with an overall grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 ("C" average). A minimum of 12 units must be completed within the Los Rios Community College District.**

*ECE 350 is a lecture/lab course. It includes a supervised structured field placement of three hours weekly (minimum of 45 hours per semester) in a local public elementary school with a college-approved certificated teacher.

^Enrollment Limitations for ECE 350: Current TB clearance is required by state law for all volunteers/teachers in education programs. The livescan background check is required by local school districts. Students may be responsible for the costs of TB clearance and livescan background check.

+Prerequisite for ENGL 301: ENGWR 300 or ENGL C1000 or ESLW 340 or ENGL 488 with a grade of "C" or better

+Prerequisite for ENGL C1001 and ENGL C1001H: College-level composition (ENGL C1000/ENGL C1000H/ENGL C1000E/C-ID ENGL 100) or equivalent

****Choose one of the recommended courses under your SLAM - Statistics and Liberal Arts Math placements (check your eServices account) except MATH 310. MATH 310 is a major requirement in a previous semester, and MATH 310 is not approved for Cal-GETC Area 2.**

2. **Completion of each required course with a grade of "C" or better for a major offered at Sacramento City College.**

3. **Completion of the California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC). Areas 1 through 6 must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.**

Students with Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate Credit (IB) test scores should notify their Counselor to learn more about how test scores may be used for credit.
